

Printer gets state funds for expansion**By Christina Olenchek - 2/8/2007**

A Lancaster County printing company will receive a \$678,000 state loan to expand in East Hempfield Township, according to a press release from Gov. Ed Rendell's office. Yurchak Printing Inc., which specializes in digital laser printing, will use the money from the Pennsylvania Industrial Development Authority to build a \$2.2 million, 35,000-square-foot building. The company has 54 employees, the release said.
