

## Download

Before you can utilize these instructions, download the necessary .zip file(s) to your desktop from the Odyssey Press web site and, for the postscript printer, follow the instructions in the READ ME FIRST text file according to your platform. The archives can be decompressed with either Stuffit Expander or WinZip:

## Reasons to utilize postscript printing.

Printing to postscript and then Distilling can solve a myriad of problems, not the least of which is the "Identity-H" font encoding that can show up in files that have been exported to PDF from InDesign. Identity-H fonts can be problematic. They aren't always, but they are unpredictable, so it's best just to avoid them. Issues from color applied to grayscale tiffs that may show up from exporting from Quark can also be avoided.

## Postscript Printing from InDesign

Once you've loaded your postscript printer, launch InDesign. From the "File" menu, choose "Print Presets" then "Define. Choose "Load" from the dialog box and navigate to the spot you saved the InDesign presets. Use the windows on the next page to make sure your settings imported correctly.

## Postscript Printing from Quark

Once you've loaded your postscript printer, launch Quark. From the "Edit" menu, Quark 7, choose "Output Styles" (in Quark 6 it's "Print Styles") and import the preset for your version of Quark. Use the windows on the last page to make sure your settings are correct.

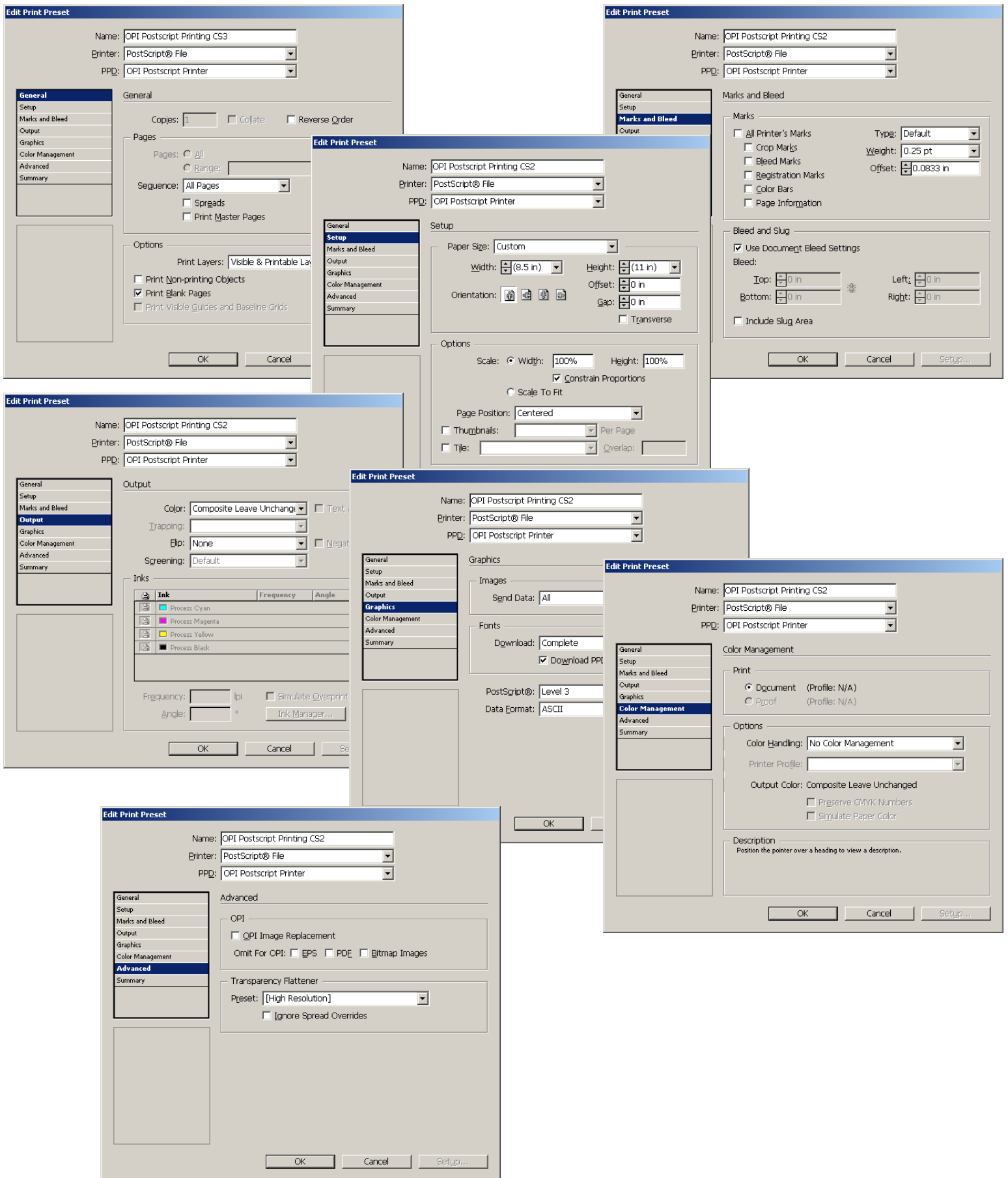
## About crop marks...

*Please do not include them* on text files. Our imposition software adds the crop marks where they are needed. However, if your document will bleed, make sure you set the original document to bleed 1/8" all around. The print preset settings from OPI will take that into account and give you the correct sheet size, e.g. a 6" x 9" will become 6.25" x 9.25"

If the file you are sending is a cover (see the document **Creating a Cover Spread.pdf**), please set the bleed to 1/2" all around (your actual bleeds only have to extend 1/8") so you can add spine marks. Then make sure you check "Crops Marks" or "Registration Marks" when printing so you will get the cover trim marks as well.

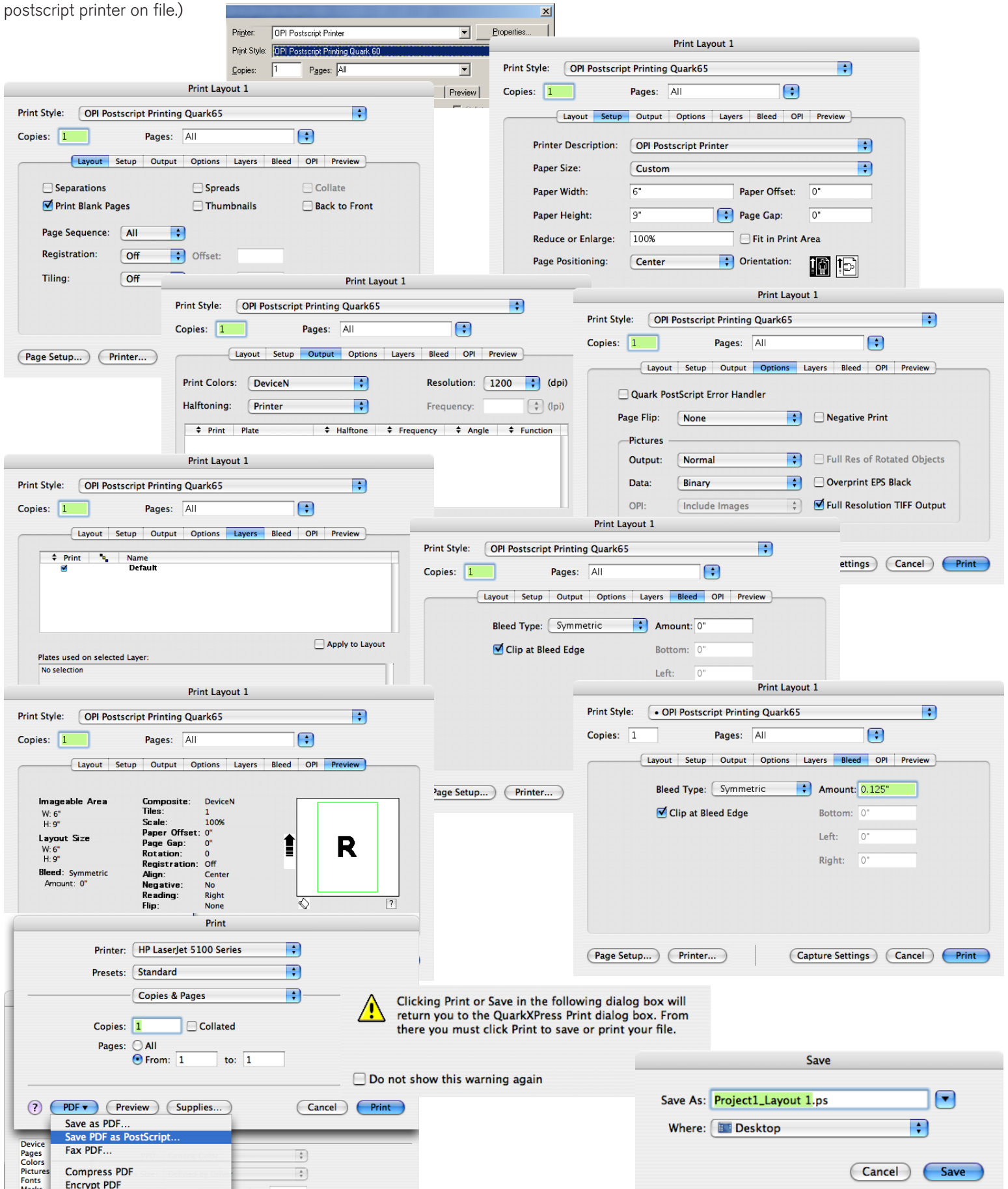
# InDesign (PC screen shots)

These categories and options are similar on both the Mac & PC platforms and for all versions. (On the PC platform you choose a postscript printer on file.)
